



**RESOLUTION SETTING TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2022;  
DIRECTING THE COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR  
TO ASSESS, COLLECT AND ACCOUNT FOR TAXES  
ASSESSED BY THE DISTRICT; AND AUTHORIZING OTHER ACTIONS**

WHEREAS, in 2003 the voters of Angelina County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1 (District) approved the levy, assessment, and collection of a tax not to exceed \$0.50 per hundred dollars of valuation to pay operating and maintenance costs of the District; and,

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the Board of Supervisors of the District held a public hearing to receive public comments on the proposed 2022 tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the tax roll for the District has been presented to the Board of Supervisors and attached are the calculations regarding the 2022 tax rates; and,


WHEREAS, the Texas Tax Code allows the District to require the county tax assessor-collector to assess, collect, and account for taxes assessed by the District thereby relieving the District of the necessity to have its own tax assessor-collector.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the District that the tax rate for the year 2022 be, and is set, in accordance with provisions of the Texas Property Tax Code, in the sum of \$0.482555 per \$100 of valuation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to Texas Property Tax Code, Chapter 6.22, the Angelina County Tax Assessor-Collector shall continue to assess, collect, and account for taxes assessed by the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President, Vice President, Secretary, and the Angelina County Tax Assessor-Collector are authorized and empowered to take any and all actions necessary to accomplish the assessment and collection of the taxes for the District.
